Every spring the Cache la Poudre River rises as mountain snows melt.

Some years there is abundant snow and the river flows high. Other years, the winter is dry and river flows are lower. Each year there is a "June Rise," a time when the river peaks from snowmelt-driven flows. This peak usually occurs sometime between May 15 and June 30.
